Holiday shipping update

There will be no shipments on the Mondays after Christmas and New Year's Day. Orders placed the prior week may experience a 3–4-day delay. We encourage pharmacy participants to plan ahead and place orders by December 14. Shipments will resume on the Tuesday after each holiday.

CDC reminder: Pharmacies enrolled in two or more FRPP programs

Per CDC, pharmacies can only participate in the FRPP for COVID-19 vaccination through one program. If you are currently enrolled in the FRPP through *Good Neighbor Pharmacy*/Elevate Provider Network and also enrolled in the FRPP through your state or CPESN, please remember to cancel your enrollment in one of the programs.

POC test & treat national certificate program

NCPA is hosting the **NASPA Pharmacy-Based Point-of-Care Test & Treat National Certificate Program**. This certificate program provides an opportunity to gain the skills and information necessary to develop a testing program such as influenza, Group A Streptococcus, HIV, Hepatitis C, coronaviruses, and chronic diseases. The target audience for the certificate program is pharmacists, pharmacy technicians, student pharmacists, academia, and pharmacy association staff. While the program is primarily

designed for pharmacists, non-pharmacists interested in point-of-care test and treat are also welcome to complete the program.

Moderna is expecting EUA approval before Christmas, possibly between 12/8-12/9. We will provide additional information upon regulatory approval.
