What is the deadline for claiming my CE credits from ThoughtSpot 2024? CE credits must be claimed by August 24th, 2024

How do I claim my CE credits from ThoughtSpot 2024?

- Log in to the <u>ThoughtSpot CE Portal</u> (https://thoughtspot.thinkingcap.com/) with your NCPA credentials. If you've claimed CE from ThoughtSpot previously, you will already have an account. If you can't remember your credentials, reset your account using the "forgot username" or "forgot Password" links on the login page
- If you don't have an NCPA login, click "Create a new account". You do NOT need to be an NCPA member to a create an account and access the portal
- Under "Claim Your CE Credits" on the home page, enter the attendance code provided during the session and click "GO".
- Click "More info" and complete the Feedback Questionnaire.
- Click the Home icon at the top of the menu bar to repeat these steps for all sessions you attended at ThoughtSpot 2024

To ensure credits are accurately submitted, confirm that your NABP E-Profile Number and date of birth are linked to your NCPA profile on the CE Portal. To do this, log in to the ThoughtSpot CE Portal and click on the settings icon in the top right corner of the screen, then click "My Profile". From here you can scroll down to confirm that your NABP E-profile number and date of birth are correctly documented.
