How do Medicare Advantage OTC benefit cards work?

Medicare Advantage plans are offering supplemental benefits to their members, including allowances for eligible over the counter (OTC) items. Plan administrators load these benefits onto prepaid debit cards offering members a convenient way to pay for their eligible OTC products. *Good Neighbor Pharmacy* wants you to be aware of this market and the ways to accept these cards so you can capitalize on an opportunity to generate additional OTC sales.

What is Cencora's relationship with the card vendors?

Cencora has no contractual relationship with any of these card vendors. The intention of this document is to inform pharmacy owners of the options and potential to accept these benefit cards in your pharmacy. We recommend owners perform their own due diligence as part of their evaluation.

Can I accept these cards directly through my point-of-sale system?

Integrations are being worked on by card vendors and POS vendors every day, please contact your POS vendor to inquire which cards can be accepted on their system.

If the cards are not integrated with my point-of-sale system, how can I enroll to accept them? 1

- Which card or cards are popular amongst my patients?
- Which card or cards are integrated with my POS?
- What are the transaction fees associated with each card?
- What is required of me to receive payment from the card vendor?

Does *Good Neighbor Pharmacy* offer any additional support to complement these programs?

Are Good Neighbor Pharmacy items available to be purchased with OTC benefits?

Good Neighbor Pharmacy products are included on the approved product libraries for the S3, Nations Benefits, and The OTC Network catalogues. Be sure to mention your affiliation with Good Neighbor Pharmacy when enrolling to ensure access.

How can I determine which plans are associated with each of the cards?

This information is considered proprietary and is not provided by the card vendors. However, we encourage you to speak to your current Medicare Advantage patients to understand what cards they may have available to use. One recommendation is to ask to see the patient's card, then you can look for the logos associated with each of the card vendors on the physical card.

How can I market to my customers that I accept these benefits cards?

When enrolling, ask the card vendor what marketing collateral they can provide to market your acceptance of their card. Additionally, if you're a *Good Neighbor Pharmacy* member, we've developed print and digital collateral as well as in-store signage to help you ensure eligible patients know your pharmacy accepts Medicare Advantage OTC benefit cards. You can print signage in Brand Central Station by navigating to the "Medicare OTC Benefit Cards" library. For additional support, please contact your advertising manager.

What OTC items are eligible for purchase with these cards?

CMS has defined product categories for eligible health-related over the counter (OTC) items. This may include items like cold and allergy medicine, vitamins, first aid essentials, and pain relievers. *Good Neighbor Pharmacy's* eligible private label items were submitted to be included on S3, Nations Benefits, and the OTC Network's product libraries.

Is there a fee for utilizing these cards?

There may be transaction fees related to accepting these cards; review those details with each individual card vendor to ensure that you are aware of all fees.

How do I receive payment from the companies?

This should be part of your evaluation for each card vendor.




1. Once logged in to ABC Order, Click on Reports from the Navigational Bar.

2. Click on View Full Template Library




3. Click on Products






4. Enter Report Name and Description then Select Show Usage Products Only and select Account(s)
